Conference Financial Aid

NTTD is offering to provide partial support to State DOT training personnel to attend the conference. The priority will be to support states that would not otherwise be represented, and personnel who have not been able to attend a conference in the past, though all requests will be reviewed and considered.



NTTD will be offering 5-10 packages of aid, up to \$1500 to defray the expenses related to attending the conference. Aid will be offered on a reimbursement basis to the individual or agency.
